Below is list of major 2010 County accomplishments and achievements. The list, while not exhaustive, reflects a number of projects that the Department, Planning Commission, Commissioners, various committees/boards, and others, including the public, completed or made substantial progress toward in 2010. The accomplishments include development review, legislative land use/growth management actions, project review/decisions, and Department administrative functions. They are not listed in any order of importance. Countless hours and significant resources were committed to make this all happen. Kudos to all involved.

Development Review

- 1. *Current planning* projects, 257 reviewed and approved (notable projects, included: Skagit Transfer Station upgrade; Anacortes Water treatment plant; and, progress toward the Welts land division and landfill remediation).
- Natural resource permit applications, 268 reviewed (critical areas review and permit applications, shoreline exemptions and permit applications, forest practice applications and mining permits). Of those, 209 have been finalized. (notable projects, included: Fisher Slough restoration; Skagit Environmental Bank; and, repair of the last failing septic system at Similk Beach to reopen Similk Bay for shellfish harvest).
- 3. *Building* permit applications, 415 reviewed and approved (notable permits, included: Marsulex, a refinery by-product, in which solid sulfur pellets are created for fertilizer; Fire District #2 a new station out on Memorial Highway; Alf Christensen Seed Co. 12,000 sq. ft. office addition to the old Transform factory near the Port; and, Skagit County Public Works transfer station project.
- 4. *Code enforcement/compliance* cases, 142 opened. Of those, 42 cases are unresolved (either more research or further legal review/action is warranted).
